As you know every girl gets a new dress, every boy a new shirt and a gift bag of "goodies" ... sweets, sunglasses, crayons, stickers, mardi gras beads ... just fun stuff. In addition we have a cake, meat sauce with rice and soda. It is really wonderful.

It's time to let me know if you are planning on coming with us this year for the Christmas trip. The dates are November 13 to 21, we will leave from Newark and come back to Newark. The rate is still only \$2,500; however, we may have to go up next time since Uganda has now implemented an 18% "tourist" tax on food, lodging and safaris! With the majority of capital improvements done on the campus, we are now focusing our efforts on establishing scholarships for our students. For a child in the primary grades it is only \$360/student and that covers food, lodging, clothing, health care and education. Once they get to secondary school that goes up to \$500. And college can range from \$1,000 to \$2,000 a year. We currently have 1,006 primary school students, 93 secondary, and 3 in college!
